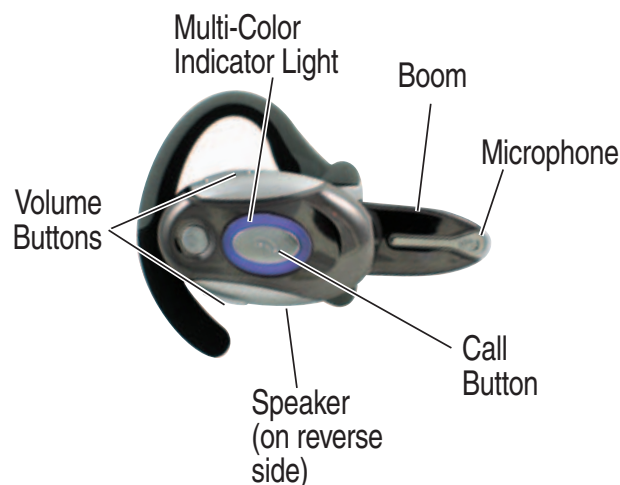

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Before using this product, read the Important Safety and Legal Information pamphlet and follow its instructions.

Take a moment before you get started to familiarize yourself with your new H700 Headset.

CHARGE YOUR HEADSET

Charge your headset's battery for 2 hours:



- 1 Plug the Motorola charger into the end of the headset.

The indicator light turns red when the battery is charging. It may take up to 1 minute for the indicator light to turn on. When the headset's battery is fully charged (about 2 hours), the indicator light turns green.

- 2 Disconnect the charger.

Note: Headset is not functional while charging.

ENSURE YOUR HEADSET IS IN PAIRING MODE

Before you can use your headset, you must pair (link) it with your phone.

Open the headset boom to initiate easy pairing. After a few moments, the indicator light will be steadily lit in purple to indicate headset is in pairing mode.

If the headset does not enter pairing mode, see **TROUBLESHOOTING** for help.

TROUBLESHOOTING

My headset will not enter pairing mode.

Make sure that any devices previously paired with the headset are turned off. If the indicator light is flashing in blue, turn off the other device, then close and reopen the headset boom. The indicator light becomes steadily lit in purple indicating the headset is now in pairing mode.

My phone doesn't find my headset.

Make sure the indicator light on your headset is on (lit in purple) and steady when your phone is searching for devices (see step 2).

My headset worked before but now it's not working.

Make sure your phone is on and the Bluetooth feature is turned on in your phone (see step 3). If the Bluetooth feature was turned off or was turned on only temporarily, you may need to restart the Bluetooth feature and pair your phone and headset again (see steps 2 and 3).

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③ TURN ON BLUETOOTH ON YOUR PHONE AND PAIR WITH HEADSET

Your phone's Bluetooth feature is off by default. To use your headset, turn on the Bluetooth feature in your phone.

To turn on Bluetooth:

- 1** Select  (Menu) > **Settings** > **Connection** > **Bluetooth Link** > **Setup**.
- 2** Scroll to **Power**.
- 3** Press **Change**.
- 4** Select **On**.
- 5** Select **Back**.
- 6** Select **Handsfree**.

Note: These steps are for most Motorola phones. For other phones, see your phone's user's guide.

TURN ON BLUETOOTH ON YOUR PHONE AND PAIR WITH HEADSET

- 7** Select **[Look for Devices]**.

***Note:** Do not select **STOP**—you will automatically be taken to the next screen.*

- 8** Select **Motorola H700**.
- 9** Select **Yes** to bond.
- 10** Enter the passkey **0000** and select **OK**.

When your headset and phone are successfully paired, the indicator light changes from steadily lit to flashing blue.

Note: These steps are for most Motorola phones. For other phones, see your phone's user's guide.

TEST AND USE

Your phone and headset are now paired and ready to make and receive calls. To confirm they are operating properly, make a call:

- 1 Place the headset over your ear. See "Wearing the Headset" on the reverse side of this guide.
- 2 On your phone, dial the number you want to call and press the **Send** key.
- 3 If your phone and headset are successfully paired, you will hear ringing on the headset.

After you have successfully paired your phone and headset, you don't need to repeat these steps. For daily use, ensure that your headset is turned ON and that your phone's Bluetooth feature is ON.

To save battery power, turn OFF the headset when you don't use it for an extended time by closing the boom.

TURNING HEADSET ON AND OFF

To turn your headset on, open the headset boom. The indicator light flashes blue.

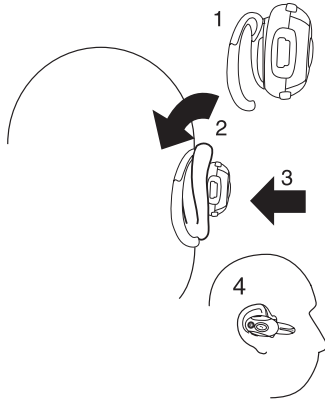
To turn your headset off, close the headset boom. The indicator light will turn off.

WEARING THE HEADSET

- 1 Open the headset boom, then open the earhook.
- 2 Loop the earhook over your ear.
- 3 Press the headset to your ear.
- 4 Point the headset boom towards your mouth.



CHANGING FOR USE ON OTHER EAR

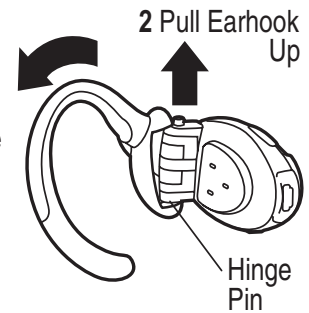
You can wear your H700 headset on your left or right ear. The headset comes ready for the right ear. To change the headset for the left ear:

- 1 Open the headset boom, then open the earhook (90° from the headset).
- 2 Gently lift and pull the top of the earhook up and off the upper hinge pin. Then, pull it away to remove it.

- 3 Flip the headset over.
- 4 Hook the bottom of the earhook onto the lower hinge pin, then lift and pull the top of the earhook over the upper hinge pin.

CHANGING VOLUME BUTTON ORIENTATION

You can also change the orientation of the volume buttons on your headset.

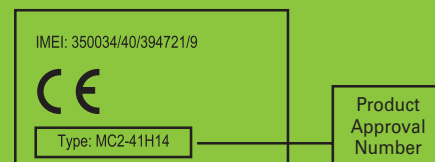
- 1 Turn the headset power off.
- 2 Press the Call button until the indicator light becomes steadily lit in purple, then press the Volume button you want to assign as the "volume up" button.

MAKING CALLS

Function	Action
Make a voice dial call	Tap the Call button and speak the name after the tone
End a call	Tap the Call button
Answer a call	Open headset boom or tap the Call button (if boom is already open)
Ignore a call	Press and hold the Call button until you hear a beep
Redial last call	Press and hold the Call button until you hear a beep

Note: Your H700 supports both Handsfree and Headset Profiles. Accessing call functions depends upon which profile your phone supports. See your phone's user's guide for more information.

MAKING CALLS *CONTINUED*

Function	Action
Answer a second incoming call	Press and hold the Call button (places first call on hold)
Toggle between two active calls	Press and hold the Call button
Join a 3-way call	Press and hold both Volume buttons
Put an active call on hold or resume a call on hold	Press and hold the Call button until you hear a beep
Transfer a call from the phone to the headset	Open headset boom
Disable the indicator light	Press and hold both Volume buttons for 3 to 4 seconds
Mute or unmute a call	Tap both Volume buttons

Note: Some features are phone/network dependent.

INDICATOR LIGHTS

With the Charger Plugged In

Indicator Light	Headset Status
Red (steady)	Charging (less than 80% charged)
Yellow (steady)	Charging (more than 80% charged)
Green (steady)	Charging complete

With No Charger Plugged In

Indicator Light	Headset Status
Off	Power off
Purple (steady)	Pairing mode/ Volume button orientation
Red	Battery low
Blue (10 rapid flashes)	Pairing successful
Blue (slow pulse)	Connected (on a call)
Blue (quick flash)	Standby (not on a call)

Note: After 5 minutes of inactivity, the light stops flashing to conserve power, but the headset remains in standby mode.

AUDIO TONES

The audio tones provide information about your headset status.

Audio Tone	Headset Status
Single high tone when pressing Volume button	Volume at minimum or maximum
Five rapid high tones repeated every 60 sec.	Low battery
No audio indications; deteriorating quality	Out of range
Ring tone	Incoming call
Single high tone	Pairing confirmation
Single low tone	Voice activation
Dual high/low tone	Voice tag not recognized
Single high tone	End call
Low to high tone	Phone network not available
Two ascending tones	Mute enabled
Two descending tones	Mute disabled
